51.	<p>Gruner Veltliner 2016, Sepp Moser, Austria</p> <p><i>Slowly gaining in popularity the Gruner Veltliner grape is Austria`s most famous and prevalent grape variety. 98.	<p>Mencia 2014, Bodegas y Vinedos Merayo, DO Bierzo, Spain <i>The red wine to match Albarino, produced in the neighbouring Bierzo region of north west Spain. Mencia is the grape variety and produces light pale red wines with very attractive flavours.</i></p>	35
88.	<p>Rioja Urbina Crianza 2008, Rioja, Spain <i>An ultra traditional estate, that believe in only releasing their wines when they are mature and ready to drink, This Crianza is light in colour and very smooth and rounded with a classical vanilla style from the oak ageing.</i></p>	48
99.	<p>Faithful Hound Red 2014, Mulderbosch, Stellenbosch, South Africa <i>One of South Africa`s great Bordeaux blend wines, this example from grapes grown around the Helderberg mountains in Stellenbosch. 92.	<p>Enira 2011, Domaine Bessa Valley, Bulgaria <i>An exciting estate owned by a group of investors, many from Bordeaux. This is a Bordeaux blend with Syrah added, aged in oak and is ripe, rich and full flavoured in style. The sweetness of the fruit matching the flavours of the Roe deer.</i></p>	56
221.	<p>Givry 1er Cru 2015, Parize Grand Vignes, Burgundy, France <i>Pinot Noir from the south of Burgundy in the Chalonnaise region, the wines here are light and elegant and with very good structure. The elegant style suits this dish well.</i></p>	75

150.	<p>Noble Late Harvest 2010, Mulderbosch, Darling Hills, South Africa</p> <p><i>A wine in the style of great Sauternes. The grapes are affected by botrytis which shrivels the grapes but leaves a very sweet and intense juice and thus a ripe sweet wine. Aged in French oak to add complexity and character.</i></p>	55
130.	<p>Colheita Vintage 1999, Feuerheed's Portugal</p> <p><i>The secret wine of the Port trade, made by the old fashioned Dutch and Portuguese houses. This is a single vintage wine aged in barrels until they wish to bottle and sell, so it is really a vintage tawny port, this example having only recently been bottled . A very smooth style of Port.</i></p>	115
